

Dear Parent/Guardian,

All students who enrol at Thornlie Senior High School and all other education or training institutes, must have a Unique Student Identifier (USI) number on enrolment.

The USI number is a mandatory government requirement for training courses. The USI gives students access to their training account and allows a student to see all of their training results from all providers including all completed training units and qualifications. This will ensure that students' training records are never lost.

The USI is available online and at no cost to the student. This USI will stay with the student for life and be recorded with any nationally recognised VET course that is completed.

On the USI website, there are some very useful documents explaining the things that you and your child need to know and how to apply for the USI. Parental consent is required to apply for this number. To require access the student will need to create their own ID when logging in for their USI number. Please also print a copy of the USI number and return this to the school as soon as possible.
