

Structure of the Program

Students enrolled in the Program will be given the opportunity to play for Thornlie Senior High School teams in the Netball WA and School Sport WA competitions. They will also be offered the chance to represent the school in Multicultural and Interstate Tours.

Netball students will receive expert coaching from the Thornlie SHS staff, Netball WA, Development Officers and guest coaches/speakers through practical and theoretical lessons.

- ➤ Year 7: Development and focus on basic skills, game play and technique. Building an understanding of rules, nutrition and fitness.
- ➤ Year 8: Development of individual skill, understanding of the History of Netball and rules of the game.
- ➤ Year 9: Development of tactics and strategies within the game. Key focus on Umpiring Development and Fitness.
- ➤ Year 10: Continued development of skills, strategies and tactics. A focus on Coaching Development and Team Management.

Selection Criteria

- 2. Selection Trials, Fitness and Skills Assessment will be carried out under the supervision of qualified staff.

- Maintain an affiliation with a Netball WA Club.
